THIS WEEK: Antelope Valley College Marauder Football (0-1) vs. Ventura Pirates (1-0), Sat., Sept. 12, Marauder Stadium, Lancaster, 7 p.m. This will be the first game played in the New Marauder Stadium - unlike most games, the stadium will open at 5:30 p.m.

THE GAME: The Marauders lost to Canyons 27-17 in a game that saw Josh Firm in his first collegiate start throw for 210 yards and two touchdowns. The Pirates opened their season with a 35-13 win over LA Valley. The series is led by the Pirates after last season's 35-7 win at 9-4.
