SOCCKER HAS CRITICAL WEEK; VOLLEYBALL HAS ONE AFTER TAKING CONTROL OF FOOTHILL CONFERENCE; CROSS COUNTRY AT SoCALS

VOLLEYBALL

THIS WEEK: Marauder Volleyball faces only Chaffey, which they beat 3-0 in Marauder Gym.

LAST WEEK: The Marauders started the week in a tie for first in the Foothill Conference with Desert and Victor Valley. AVC dropped both those teams to take a firm lead in conference play and extend their winning streak to seven matches - the longest since 1993 when AVC won 13 straight.

CROSS COUNTRY

THIS WEEK: Marauder Cross Country travels to Walnut to compete in the Southern California Championships. Teams and individuals will be qualified for the state meet.

LAST WEEK: Marauder Cross Country traveled to Palm Desert to compete in the Foothill Conference championships - with both teams finishing second in conference. For the men it was the eighth time in 11 years that they finished second to San Bernardino Valley. **Ulises Aquino** (5-9, 140, FR, Palmdale (Pete Knight '09)) was individually fourth for the Marauders and **PJ Zaragoza** (5-8, 130, FR, Lancaster (Lancaster '09)) was eighth, giving them All-Conference honors. On the women's side **Caitlin Choate** (5-5, FR, Palmdale (Highland '09)) was second, **Sue-Ann Marteaux** (5-6, FR, Lancaster (Lancaster '07)) was fourth and **Anaiz Ortiz** (5-2, FR, Palmdale (Palmdale '09)) was eighth - each was an All-Conference performance. Choate's second place finish broke a five year streak of an Marauder winning the women's individual title.

THIS WEEK: The Marauders play the two toughest teams in the conference after themselves and San Bernardino Valley.

LAST WEEK: The Marauders beat Victor Valley 2-0, then lost 3-1 at home to San Bernardino Valley. In two years, the only team to beat AVC at home is the Wolverines. The loss put San Bernardino Valley squarely in place for the conference title and the Marauders in second place.

RECORD: The Marauders win over Victor Valley gave them 13 wins on the season, meaning they took over sole possession of the record for most in a season. Last year's squad went 12-7-1.
